I have been lobbying the Star to do a check on Corwin 's travel records. He is out of town ALL the time and I think it would be a great story that our chief is gone so much with all the critical issues facing the department.

Without writing a statement, here are some thoughts:

First I would stay away from the social issues other maybe a reference to "there are societal issues that also play a role in the level of violet crime in our urban core".

Hear are further suggestions for language:

I have done some research on what is called "shot shooter" which is new technology that alerts the police to the exact location from which a gun shot is launched. I believe they have experimented with these sensors in St. Louis (don 't know if that is true but I thought you told me that once). It is expensive but there are federal grants available for the system. I have urged the PD to look into this. I believe that if this system worked it would put shooters on notice that someone is "watching them" all the time and would allow the police to quicky respond to an area where shots are fired.

Secondly I believe with the rise in killings the police need to be more aggressive in pursuing individuals who are likely to engage in violent, gang related crime. Many times when a suspect is arrested for serious crime the individual already has warrants out for their arrest. The police need to stop ignoring warrants from the courts and go out and pick these people for existing warrants before they graduate to a high level of crime. The police do sweeps but that is not working.

We are at war with violent criminals and the police need to examine their tactics and treat it as a war. Excuses are no longer acceptable.

Cathy---I know you don't like to take on the police but if you don't line down a tough line with them you start to inherit the problems of crime at the next election. They cannot hide behind budgets because this increase in crime has come with them fully funded over the last 10 years.

When you write to Hendricks you need to mention you are chair of the Public Safety committee because he is not likely to know that. It would help get you quoted too if that is your goal.

> Folks, this is Mike Hendricks at the KC Star. I'm writing a column dealing  
> with the recent shootings (and those that went before) involving innocent  
> folks being killed, injured or traumatized by stray bullets. There were the  
> two women killed on the East Side 10 days ago. Five days later, a man in van  
> was almost killed by a stray bullet during a rolling gun battle at Meyer and  
> 71 highway. In March, a guy was killed on his sister's porch when shooters  
> tried to kill the neighbors next door. A man almost died in December when a

- > stray bullet passed through an ATA bus at 41st and Prospect.
- > A check of the Star's electronic library lists many more similar incident in
- > the same general neighborhood at all times of day. Also, some of you may
- > remember when an east-side rolling gun battle that began at 71 and Swope
- > Pkway ended up in Brookside a couple of years ago on a busy weekday aftern
- > noon. It's amazing no innocent bystander died that day.
- > As leaders of the city, what do you think this says about Kansas City? And
- > what needs to be done about?
- > More than \$30 million has been invested into Starlight Theatre over the past
- > couple of decades. How many more shootings will it take before average folks
- > stop going?
- > I'm writing this column on Tuesday for Wednesday's paper, so early responses
- > will be more likely to be included.
