He's asking if the total number of petition signatures matches the total number verified by the counties. ie If a total of 1000 signatures were received and the Counties (Jackson, Platte, Clay & Cass) came back with 250, 250, 248, and 250 voters names checked. Then you would know that some of the names were overlooked or not checked (250+250+248+250 does not equal the 1000 total signatures received). Did the total number of signatures received match the number checked by the 4 counties?

He was not asking about the valid/ invalid number of signatures- only the totals
